What is BASEFund?

BASEFund is a Secarma initiative specifically designed to support SMEs, charities, and CICs in accessing essential cybersecurity services without financial roadblocks.

The funding can be applied for by any organisation, regardless of size, sector, or prior security experience, as long as you're progressing your journey and it's your first time accessing the service with Secarma.

Our goal is simple: make robust security achievable from day one.

Eligible organisations can access up to £10,000 of support towards services from Cyber Essentials certification through to continuous testing. This structured programme removes the cost barrier to foundational cyber resilience.

All projects are booked on a first-come, first-served basis, so be aware that you might need to be flexible on dates.



Who Can Apply?

BASEFund is designed to support organisations taking the next step on their cybersecurity journey, whether that means achieving certification, gaining greater visibility through assessment, or advancing their security maturity.

Eligibility Criteria:

- You haven't previously accessed the specific service through Secarma
- You are within your first 12 months of engaging with us for that service

Or any UK-based:

- Registered Charity
- Community Interest Company (CIC)

All applications are reviewed internally. BASEFund allocations are discretionary.



Why BASEFund

Cybersecurity shouldn't be out of reach. BASEFund removes the cost barrier, helping you take the first step towards resilience, protecting your data, building stakeholder trust, and supporting long-term growth backed by security.



How to Apply?

Step 1: Initial Check

Your Secarma Account Manager or Sales contact will verify eligibility based on the above criteria. If your organisation qualifies, we'll move forward with a tailored proposal.

Step 2: Review & Proposal

Our cybersecurity team will review each application. If approved, we'll issue a formal proposal outlining the services offered and the associated BASEFund discount.

Step 3: Acceptance & Scheduling

- Proposals must be accepted within 30 days
 - Work must be scheduled within 3 months of acceptance
 - All projects are booked on a first-come, first-served basis
